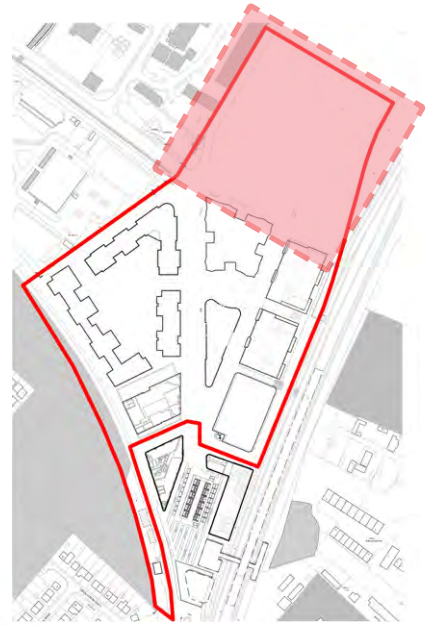


# LANDSCAPE AND OPEN SPACE HARD LANDSCAPE WILD PARK

## KEY

-  Site boundary
-  Tarmac to road  
All adopted roads to CCC standards.
-  Granite setts to loading bay and basement entry  
CED granite, colour: silver-grey; 100x100x80, laid staggered bond. Tumbled
-  Granite setts to pedestrian crossing points  
CED granite, pink-grey; 100x100x100, laid staggered bond. Flamed finish.
-  Existing charcoal block paving to be retained,  
or reinstated following construction where required. 200x100
-  Block paving to raised tables, to match Station Square  
200x100x80mm (LxWxD), laid in herringbone. To CCC standards
-  Block paving to ramp, to match Station Square  
200x100x80mm (LxWxD), laid in stretcher bond perpendicular to traffic direction.  
To CCC standards.
-  Block paving to parking spaces  
Charton Stonemaster; colour Amber Buff. 200x100x80 (LxWxD),
-  Block paving to Cycle path  
Marshall Modal; colour Oatmeal. 200x100x80 (LxWxD), laid stretcher bond  
in direction of travel
-  Block paving to pedestrian pavement  
Marshalls Modal; colour Oatmeal Granite. 600x300x80 (LxWxD), laid stretcher bond
-  'Gravel safe' loose surfacing to contained play areas  
Impact absorbing rounded gravel products supplied by CEDEC, conformin to BS-EN 1176 and BS-EN 1177
-  Trail - Gravel/Breedon gravel
-  Decking, FSC hardwood
-  Extent of temporary construction logistics area

# LANDSCAPE AND OPEN SPACE FURNITURE STRATEGY (WEST)

## KEY

-  Site boundary
-  Upcycled hardwood rustic benches  
"Drifter" from Streetlife, 2000x300x450 (lwxh) with some longer at 3000mm. Intermittent backs and armrests. In single and 'L-shape' configurations
-  Upcycled hardwood 'pouf'  
"Drifter" from Streetlife, in configuration of 1200x1200 for form playful platform or lounging bench
-  Timber slatted bench on steel legs  
"Plateu" by Logic or similar; in FSC hardwood, with partial backs and single armrests; legs in powder coated steel; 1980x695 (lwx).
-  Timber slat seating incorporated into raised corten planters, generally over basements.  
"Plateu" by Logic or similar; in FSC hardwood, with partial backs and single armrests. With lighting strips to bases in Chesterton Square. Corten planters at 450 to 600mm height, with dropped basement where possible. Ventilation grilles to planter fronts, beneath bench.
-  Concrete low seating kerb  
Bespoke curved concrete kerbs, 350x350mm (wxh) for seating;
-  Hardwood timber pergola  
225x225mm posts and cross beams; irregular spacing with stainless steel wire strung between. FSC hardwood timbers, red cedar or oak
-  Timber raised beds  
Raised beds for community growing. 100x100mm timbers stacked horizontally with staggered corners to 600 height.
-  Tree grilles in Corten steel grid mesh  
1200x1200mm "Transparent" by Streetlife or similar
-  Sheffield stainless steel cycle stands  
Either angled where space is limited or at 90 deg; includes some long stands for non-standard cycles
-  Ventilation grille to basement
-  Ventilation grille to face of benches

Number of Visitor Cycle Stands  
1 Milton Avenue:  
22 - Standard Sheffield stands (44 spaces)  
3 - Oversized Sheffield stands (6 spaces)

Residential:  
49 - Standard Sheffield stands (98 spaces)  
5 - Oversized Sheffield stands (10 spaces)

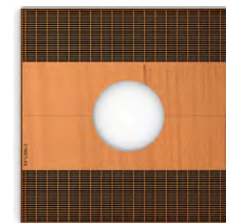
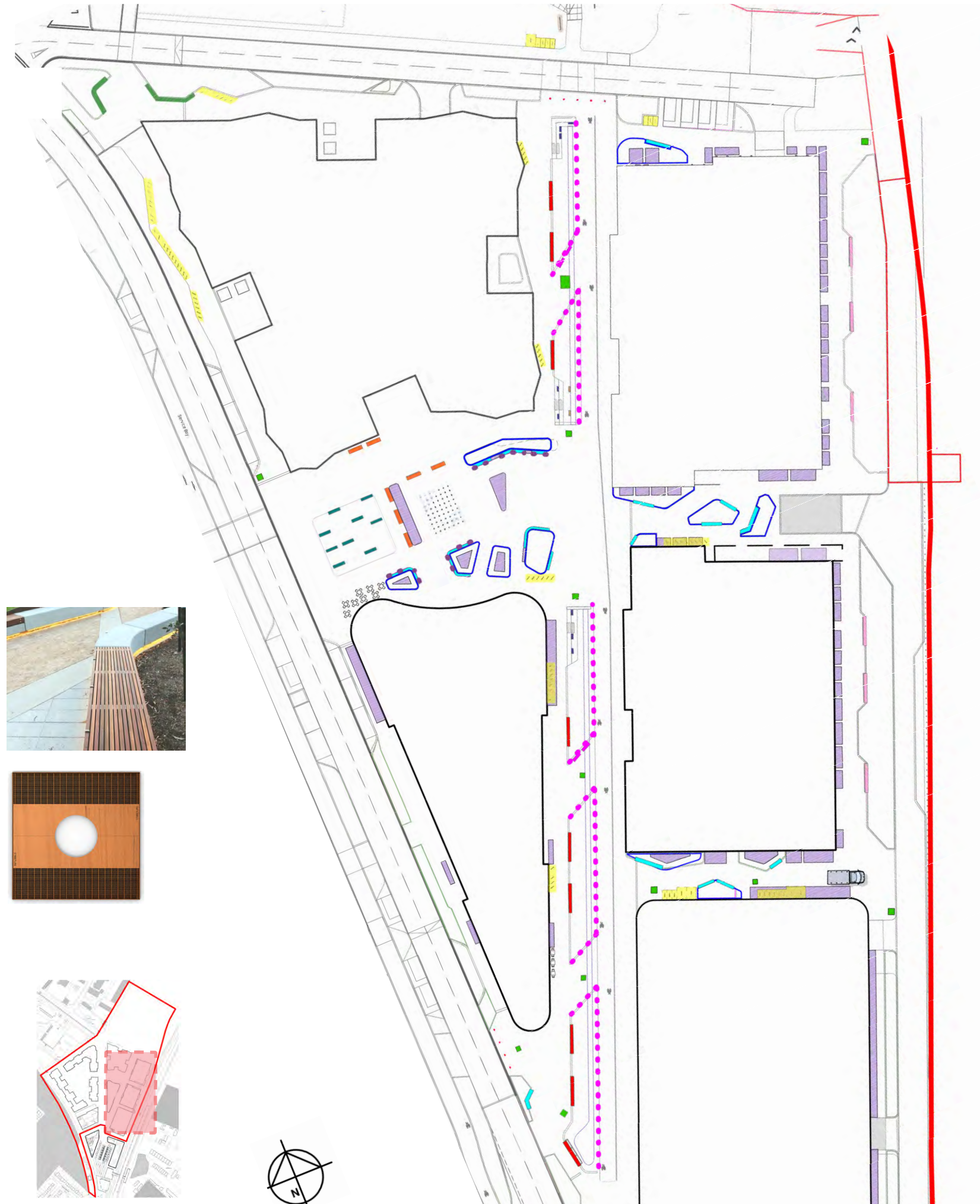
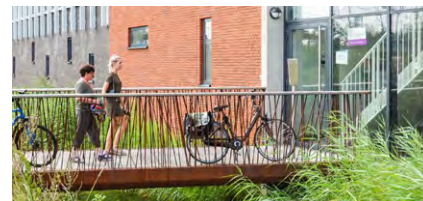

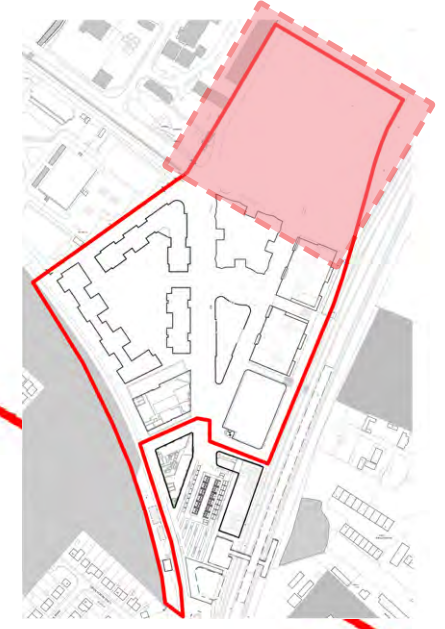
## KEY






-  Site boundary
-  Block bench in Corten steel with timber seating  
'San Marco' by Streetlife or similar approved; 1500mm length
-  Timber topped slatted bench with backrest atop polished concrete base.  
Streetlife timber slatted seats and backs with intermittent armrests; affixed to angled concrete base; length 3000mm
-  Concrete angular modular bench  
'Mesa' by Furnitubes; Colour: Light Grey; with 120 deg Elbow module
-  Timber slat seating incorporated into raised corten planters.  
'Plateu' by Logic or similar; in FSC hardwood, with partial backs and single armrests. With lighting strips to bases in Chesterton Square.
-  Timber slatted bench on steel legs  
'Plateu' by Logic or similar; in FSC hardwood, with partial backs and single armrests; legs in powder coated steel; 1980x695 (lwx).
-  Long polished concrete benches  
'Abril' by Escofet or similar, 2960 x 750x450mm (lwxh)
-  Inset timber seats to oversize 'steps'  
FSC hardwood slats, 600 x 1000mm affixed to concrete 'risers'
-  Tree grilles in Corten steel grid mesh  
1200x1200mm 'Transparent' by Streetlife or similar
-  Sheffield stainless steel cycle stands  
Either angled where space is limited or at 90 deg; includes some long stands for non-standard cycles
-  Ventilation grille to basement
-  Ventilation grille to face of benches
-  Corten railing to cycle lane/swale interface  
'Wild Bowie' or similar by Streetlife
-  Stainless steel bollard, 140mm diam  
Marshalls Geo or similar. With locking key for fire access

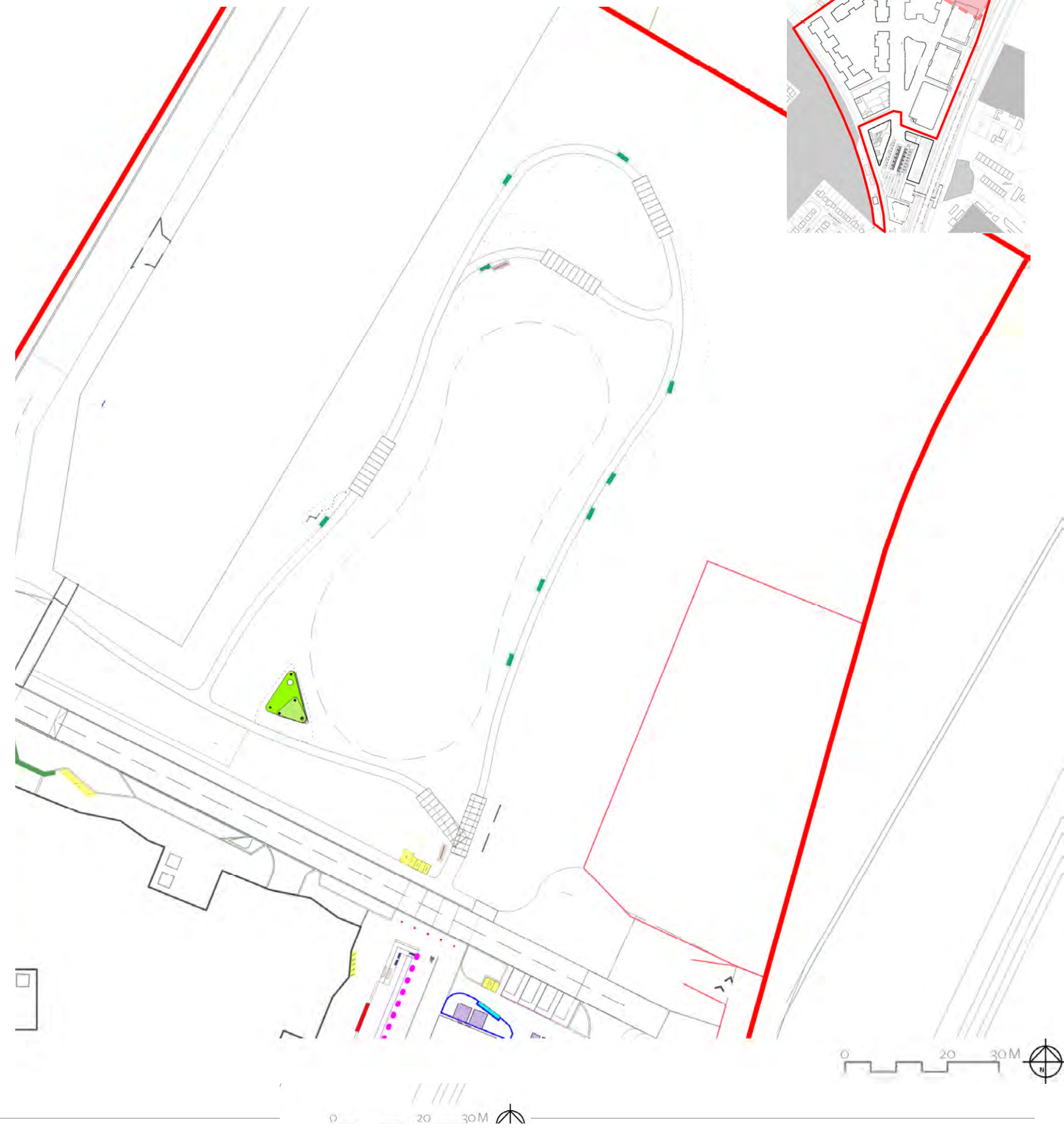
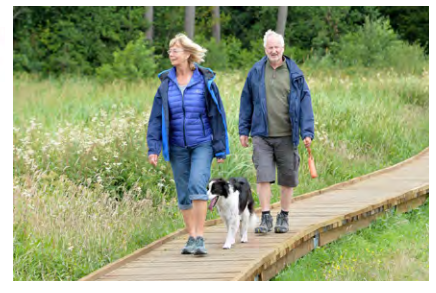




# LANDSCAPE AND OPEN SPACE FURNITURE STRATEGY WILD PARK



- KEY**
-  Site boundary
  -  Rustic timber bench: Edale Rustic 3-slat seat by Broxap or similar; in Iroko hardwood
  -  Deck and shelter for youth/park users  
Hardwood decking with timber canopy and built in seat; bespoke design to be detailed by specialist
  -  Sheffield stainless steel cycle stands  
Either angled where space is limited or at 90 deg; includes some long stands for non-standard cycles
  -  Interpretation board  
Information on Open Mosaic Species/History of Chesterton sidings to be agreed with council

 4 - Standard Sheffield stands (8 spaces)  
 1 - Oversized Sheffield stands (2 spaces)
