Longstanton walking Route 5Km



Start/Finish:

This walk takes in the surroundings of Longstanton, but not the village centre itself. It can be shortened at a number of points and walkers should be aware that some sections maybe muddy after rain.

- 1 Start in the car park of the Black Bull pub. Take the footpath at the back of the car park and continue across Prentice Close into a passageway between a house and bungalow.
- Follow this narrow path until it divides. Go left. The new Northstowe site is on your right.
- 3 At Station Road turn left. Just after passing Mitchcroft Road, take the lane on the right (Fews Lane) and continue to an open green area.
- Walking counter clockwise, cross the second bridge into Home Farm estate. Turn left, then right, pass through a gate and turn left on to Over Road. Continue along the road as far as the roundabout.
- Cross the roundabout and go straight on, walking across two fields. Cross Hatton's Road and continue along the field edge to School Lane.
- Turn left, then right into Woodside opposite All Saints' Church. Continue along the road until you reach St Michael's Church.
- 7 Turn left by the church, continue past a mobile home park and take the green lane (Long Lane) that continues straight on at the point where the road bends to the left.
- Follow the path round to Rampton Road. Beware, this area is likely to be muddy! Ahead you will see a WW2 pill box. Take the path through a gate to the left of the pill box. Follow the path through a second gate, then continue until you reach the point where you originally joined the path.
- 9 Turn left and retrace your steps to the Black Bull car park.

Terrain:

1hr 30 (leisurely)

5km (shortcuts possible)

Start/finish: Black Bull PH car park or Recreation Ground car park. Citi 5 bus stop is opposite the pub.

Point A - is an alternative start for people arriving from the guided busway, Northstowe or Willingham.

Amenities:

- Pub Shop
- Toilets and the park & ride or at the Pavilion on the Rec.

Surface/Terrain:

- EasyTarmac path/road
- Muddy sections in winter or wet weather
