I write in connection with the above representation and in light of the consideration within the report referred to the Planning Policy and Localism Portfolio Holder on the 13th December 2012 – Appendix J – Sustainability Appraisal.

We have noted that our suggestion the properties along Abbotsley Road and the A428 be incorporated within a village framework is rejected by officers on the grounds 'An isolated cluster of residential properties to the south of A428, with an office and converted garage to the west, and large business units to the north of the A428. The business units would not be suitable for inclusion'. We note that no changes are proposed, but the statement does not provide any explanation of the reasons for the rejection of the representation.

Can you please clarify the officer's stance in respect of the representation we have made. If it is the case officers consider it inappropriate, can you please clarify how this 'squares' with the attached examples of small groups of comparable numbers of properties or areas, which are incorporated within a village framework boundary.
