

Dear Miss Graham and Mr Wood,

With reference to our previous update letters<sup>1</sup> regarding the progress of further evidence base work on student accommodation, Gypsies and Travellers and accessible homes, I can confirm that the Council has now completed these strands of evidence base work and is now submitting the results of the work to the Examination.

The Council agreed a number of further proposed modifications and to submit the following documents to the Examination at Full Council on 23 February 2017. The documents submitted are as follows:

- Accessible Housing in Cambridge: A study into accessible housing requirements in Cambridge for the emerging Local Plan (January 2017) (RD/CFM/040).
