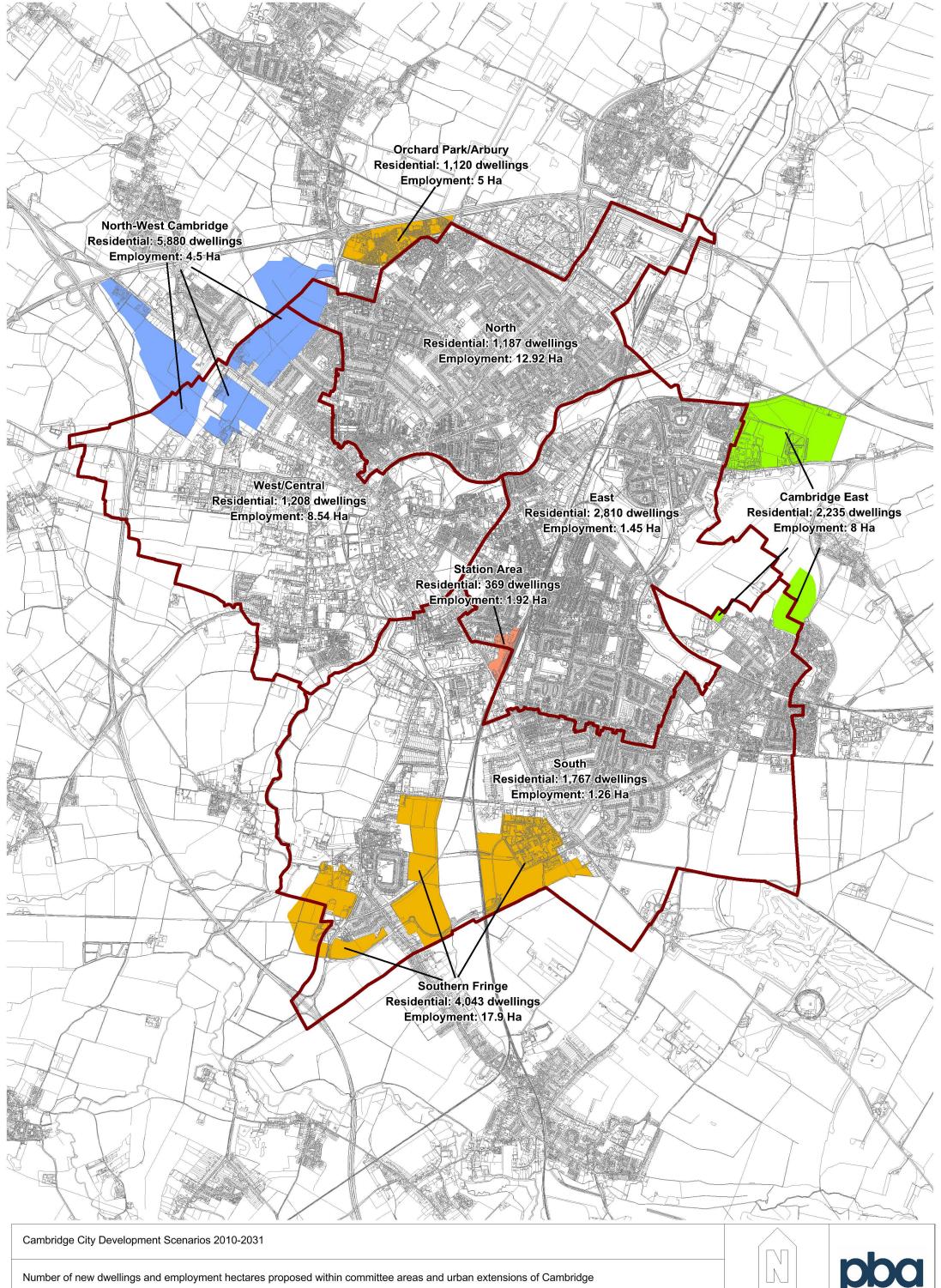

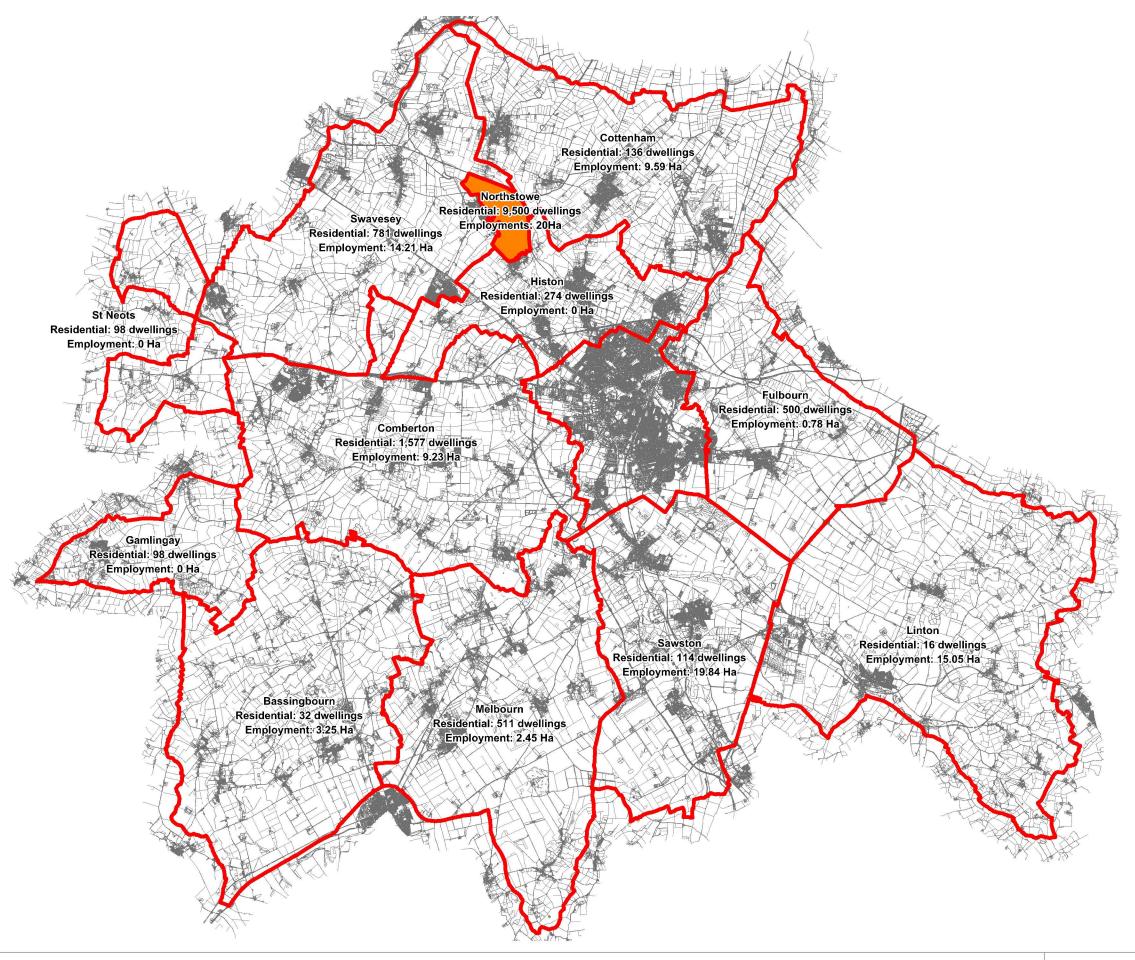

South Cambridgeshire Development Scenarios 2010-2031

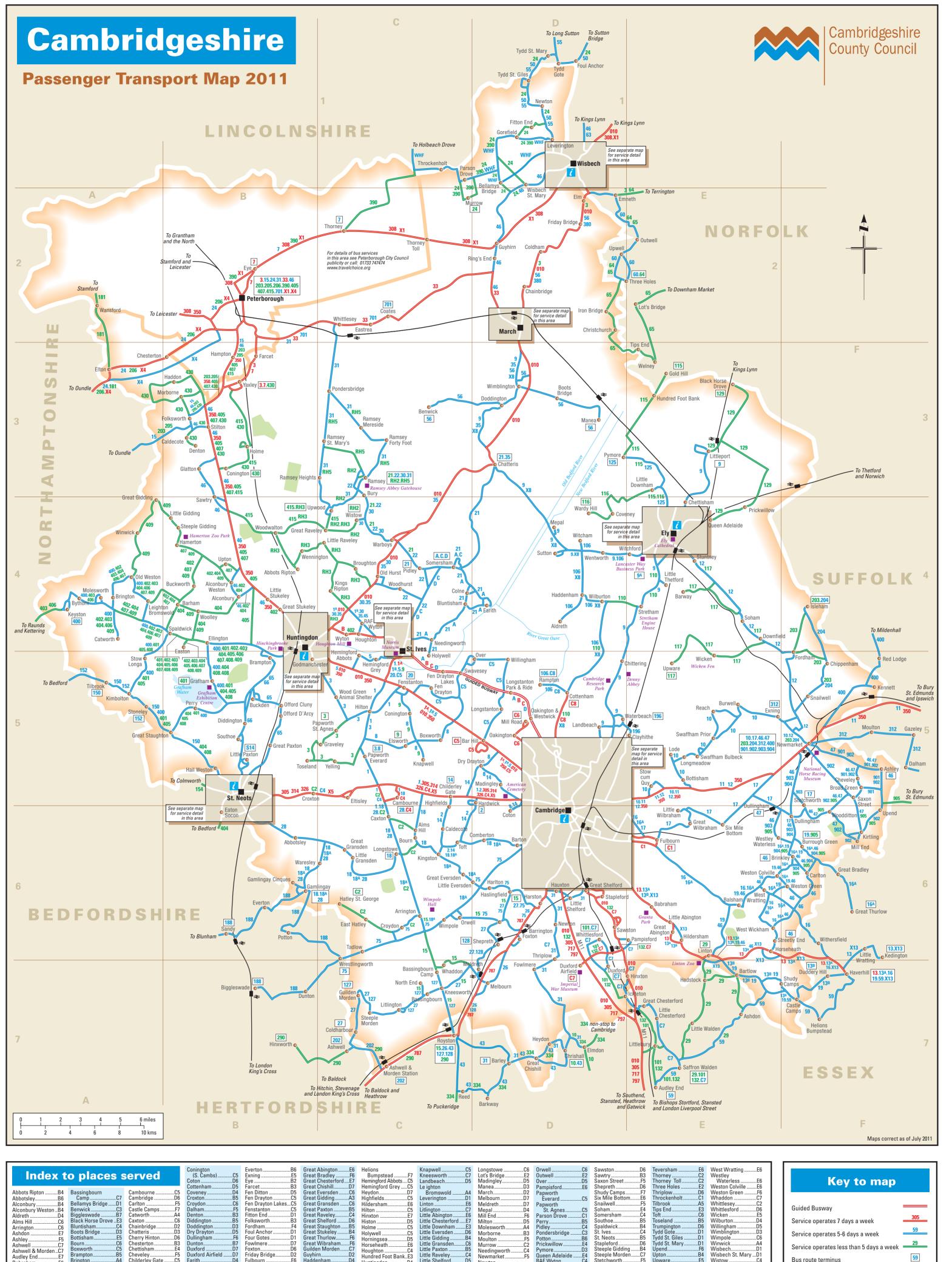
Number of new dwellings and employment hectares proposed within secondary school catchment areas across South Cambridgeshire and Northstowe

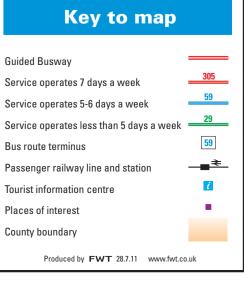


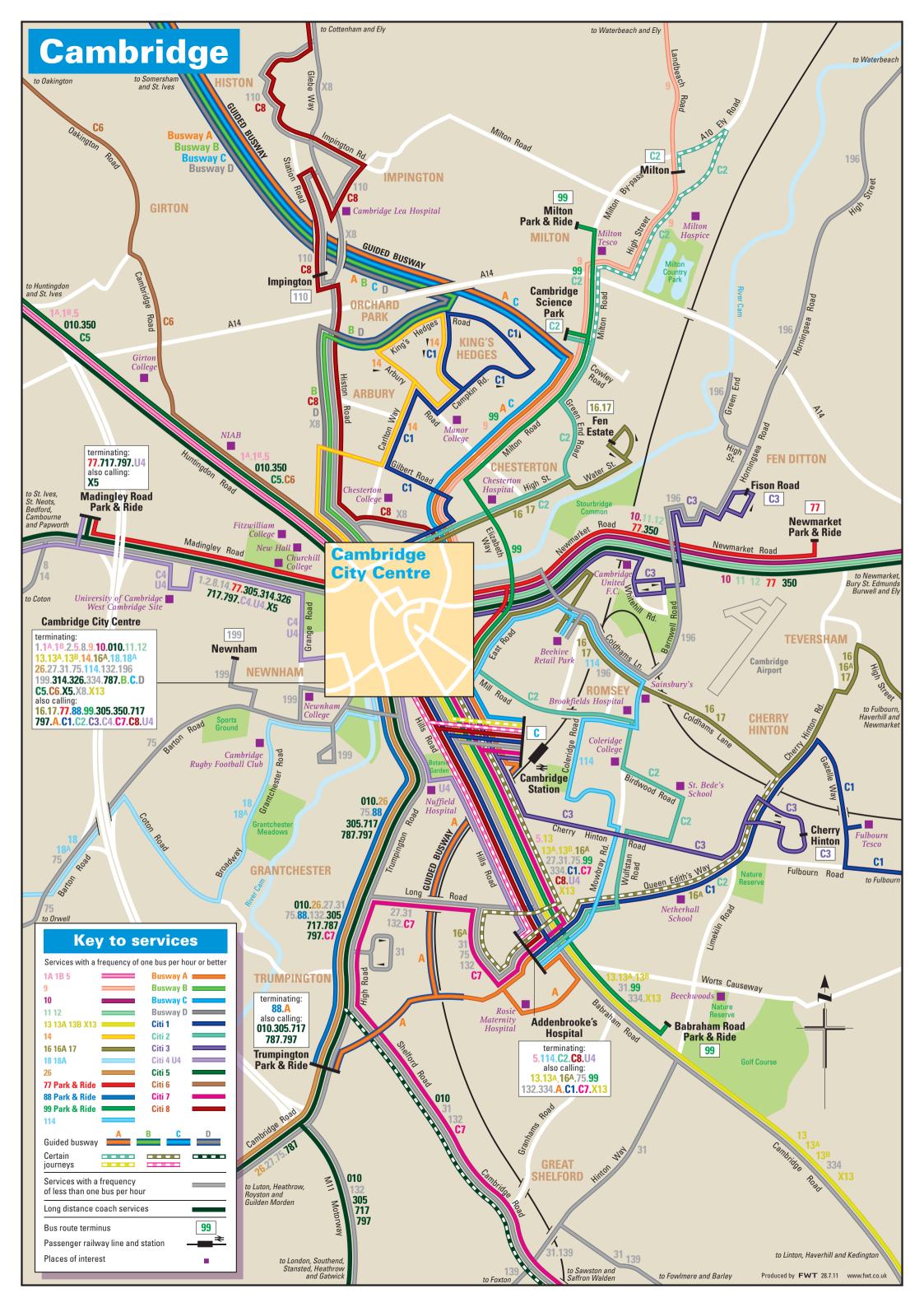
