#### **Errata - Appendix 5: Proposed Minor Modifications to the Submission Cambridge Local Plan**

Appendix 5 of the Councils' M9 Statement contains an error in the proposed minor modifications table to the Cambridge Submission Local Plan. The following extract from Appendix 5 shows in <u>red</u> where text is proposed to be corrected.




