Wilbraham Woodlands

Description: Plant six trees in the village

Funding: £1,000

Description: Plant 80 trees to absorb carbon, increase biodiversity and inspire residents

Funding: £3,611

Living Food Bank – Climate Cafes

Description: Link local people to build local vegetable plots as living food banks; trees and seeds planted

Funding: £4,150

Description: Tree and hedge planting around Cambourne Cricket Pitch; community involvement with school; 1,200 trees and shrubs planted
