Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambridge, CB23 6EA by 5pm on Tuesday 8 April 2025. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Monday 31 March 2025. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Monday 31 March 2025.
